**1 Attendance and Apologies**

1.1 No apologies were received.

**3 Wales Pension Partnership; DCLG Autumn Review Submission and Work stream Summary**

3.1 The HoP highlighted the following key headlines from the report:

- The report and appendices provided the present position in respect of the creation of the all Wales collective investment arrangements.
- Appendix 1 provided the most recent update on progress submitted to the DCLG as required.

- In terms of scale (Criterion A), the total value of the all Wales pool in July 2016 was £12.8bn. This was lower than the desired size set by DCLG but was accepted due to the unique characteristics of the pool. The total value of assets as at 30 June 2017 was £16.3bn.
- The passive investment management framework had resulted in lower fees and costs during the previous 18 months.
- Not all investments could be immediately transferred into the pool, as they were fixed-term investments.
- The pool was still targeting to go live by April 2018.
- Carmarthenshire was the host authority, with an agreed budget on behalf of all eight Welsh funds.
- Discussions were ongoing regarding the design of sub-funds and would be discussed with the Operator once appointed.
- FCA authorisation and transition of assets would also be discussed with the Operator once appointed.
- The risks to the delivery timescale could be seen in the table on pages 9 and 10 of the agenda.
- In terms of governance (Criterion B), all eight Welsh funds had agreed to work together under a legal agreement.
- Regarding reduced costs and value for money (Criterion C), the estimated savings figures quoted in the July 2016 proposal could be seen in the table on page 12 of the agenda.
- In respect of Criterion D, he reaffirmed that it was the Welsh Pool's ambition to have at least 5% of assets invested in infrastructure investments in the short to medium term, with a longer term aspiration set at 10%. At 30 June 2017, the figure stood at £180m (1.1%).
- Discussions had taken place with the other investment pools throughout the country, to see if investments in infrastructure could be done as a pan-LGPs (Local Government Pension Scheme) collective.
- Appendix 2 provided a timeline as a point of reference, in relation to the Governance Workstream and the Procurement Workstream.

### 3.2 The Chair added the following points:

- In terms of the Procurement Workstream, the recommendation had now been agreed by JGC (Joint Governance Committee), hence why the Pensions Committee were considering their recommendations in item 5 of the agenda.
- Infrastructure was a good investment class but was difficult to get right.
- In terms of the DCLG deadline of April 2018, he believed it may be better to take a couple of months longer, if it became necessary, in order to complete the process correctly.
